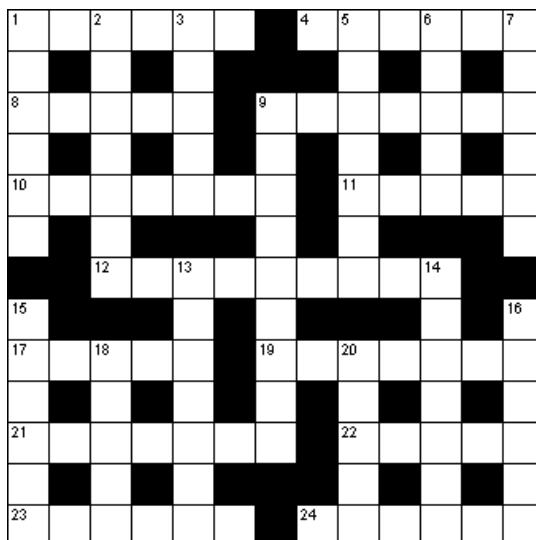

From the Oracle Historian Archives: A rare Victorian riot in Orton Waterville

Many small villages, like Orton Waterville, would have been very peaceful in Victorian times.

However, in August 1853, this sleepy village bore witness to uproar when a riot took place. A group of Irish agricultural labourers entered the village, causing local men to fear that they would lose their jobs to these brazen newcomers. The result of this anxiety culminated in a massive fight with the Irishmen being driven out of the village.

A warrant was subsequently signed by a local magistrate for the arrest of the Orton ringleaders. A police constable came from Peterborough with the intention of apprehending the alleged five ringleaders, three of whom he found mowing in Slater's Meadow (a field off Ham Lane). The police constable's

statement read: 'I waited until they had finished mowing, then told the three I had a warrant for their arrest for driving off the Irishmen. These three men were Jackson Allen, William Austen, and George Ladds. Another man with them, Samuel Austen, then brandished a stick saying that no one would be taken, and George Ladds unslung his scythe and said: 'Here's one B- - - - - that don't mean to be taken. I'll chop the first B- - - - - that touches me.' I (the PC) then said, 'Put it down, if you touch me with that cold steel I'll blow a hole through you.'



It would appear that the gathering then moved down the village street, reaching The Windmill Inn, where 30-40 people were congregated, including some women with sticks, who said: 'No one will be taken tonight'. One elderly man seemed to be egging the others on. When the police constable enquired who it was, he was told that it was John Austen who was stirring up the village folk, making the situation worse.

The fracas resulted in arrests and a court appearance for Jackson Allen, William Austen, and George Ladds, who were all charged with threatening behaviour and public order offences likely to cause a breach of the peace. Two were fined for driving off the Irishmen and bound over to keep the peace. George Ladds was additionally charged with threatening a police constable in the execution of his duty and was given a short custodial sentence for all three offences. It's not known whether the police executed the warrants on the other two men from the original gang of five ringleaders. Perhaps they had lucky escapes from the long arm of the law!

***The Peanut Butter Falcon* (2019)**
: PG-13 | **Length:** 1 hour 37 minutes

If you're in the mood for something uplifting, funny, and full of heart, *The Peanut Butter Falcon* is a great pick. It follows Zak, a young man with Down syndrome, who runs away from a care home to chase his dream of becoming a professional wrestler. Along the way, he crosses paths with Tyler, a guy down on his luck, and Eleanor, who's trying to bring Zak back. Instead, the three end up on an

unexpected journey that changes all their lives.

This movie is all about friendship, freedom, and finding your own way in the world—even if it's messy and unpredictable. It's the kind of story that makes you laugh, maybe shed a tear, and definitely feel good by the end. The performances are fantastic, especially from Zack Gottsagen, who brings so much honesty and charm to the screen.

With its southern landscapes, lovable characters, and a warm, adventurous spirit, *The Peanut Butter Falcon* is a perfect film to bring people together. It's suitable for teens and adults, with just a little bit of language and rough edges—but nothing that overshadows the heart of the story.

Bottom line: Sweet, funny, and totally worth watching.

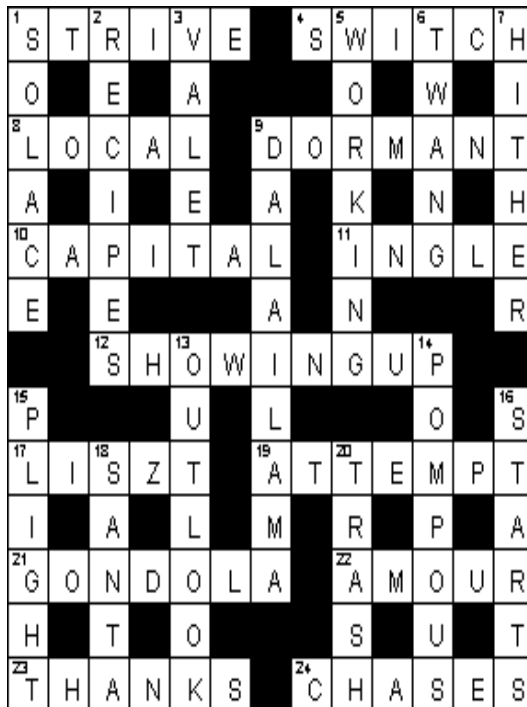
